



TCUK Insurance Statement

1. Purpose

Taekwondo Council UK (TCUK) is committed to ensuring that appropriate insurance arrangements are in place to support the safe delivery of taekwondo activities and to protect participants, instructors, clubs, and the organisation.

This statement sets out TCUK's **insurance expectations and requirements** and supports compliance with the **Safeguarding Code Governing Organisations Checklist (Item 6)**.

2. Scope

This statement applies to:

- Taekwondo Council UK (TCUK)
 - All TCUK Full Member Clubs
 - All instructors, assistant instructors, and officials operating under TCUK recognition
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3. TCUK Insurance Cover

TCUK does **not** act as an insurer and does **not directly provide insurance cover**. However, access to **insurance benefits is available as part of TCUK Full Membership**.

These insurance benefits are arranged as a membership benefit and are subject to the terms and conditions of the relevant insurance provider. Full Member Clubs and instructors should **contact TCUK directly for detailed information** regarding the insurance benefits available, including scope and conditions of cover.

TCUK also maintains appropriate insurance cover to support its role as a governing organisation, including governance and management activities. Insurance arrangements are reviewed periodically to ensure they remain appropriate.

4. Club and Instructor Insurance Requirements

4.1 Club Insurance

All TCUK Full Member Clubs must:

- Hold appropriate insurance cover relevant to their activities
- Ensure insurance remains valid for the duration of their membership

- Comply with any insurance-related conditions or requirements issued by TCUK

4.2 Instructor Insurance

All instructors and assistant instructors must:

- Hold valid and appropriate insurance cover for their role
 - Ensure their insurance remains current
 - Provide evidence of insurance when requested
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5. Verification and Monitoring

- Insurance cover is checked as part of the club and instructor membership process
 - TCUK reserves the right to request proof of insurance at any time
 - Failure to maintain appropriate insurance may result in restrictions on recognition or membership
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6. Responsibilities

TCUK

- Set insurance expectations and requirements
- Monitor compliance where appropriate

Full Member Clubs

- Ensure appropriate insurance cover is in place
 - Maintain records of insurance documentation
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7. Review

This statement will be reviewed every **3 years**, or sooner if required by changes in legislation, insurance arrangements, or governance standards.
